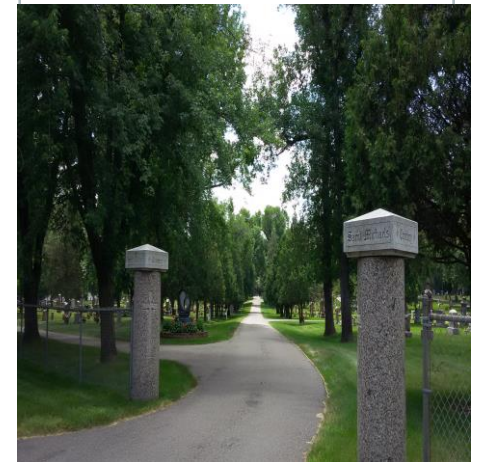

Definitions

1. A **Conventional Grave** is limited to one Conventional Burial or two Cremation Burials.
2. A **Second Right of Burial** is permitted and allows for one additional burial on the conventional grave. For example, one conventional burial and one cremation burial.
3. **Memorial** includes a monument or marker. A **monument** is an upright, above ground headstone; a **marker** is a headstone or footstone that is level with the ground.

Hours- Summer: 8:00 am-9:00 pm

Winter : 8:00 am-5:00 pm

our lives as they pass away. Our rules and regulations are to maintain the safety and beauty of the Cemetery.

Winter decorations may be placed on a grave from November 15th to March 31st. Only live greens or wreaths on stands or in pots are permitted.

Summer decorations may be placed on a grave by May 1st to September 30th. Only live plants in clay, concrete or metal pots on 18" round patio stones allowed. Planter stands, ornamental pot hangers and other decorations are not permitted.

Pets on leash only and clean up is required.

Unused Graves and Lots may NOT be privately re-sold to another individual. Unused Grave Lots may be transferred to St. Charles Church at the original purchase price or donated. For further questions, or to see a complete list of cemetery rules please call the office at 651-439-4511.
